Smoky Mountain Gathering

In an effort to fully and completely protect the health and welfare of all Smoky Mountain Gathering delegates, during the current COVID-19 pandemic, and to allow us to resume our annual Senior Adult Retreat, the following procedures will be implemented and maintained until further notice:

- If you are sick or showing any signs of sickness, you should not register. If symptoms develop while attending the SMG retreat, you should leave immediately.
- Please notify your group leader or a representative from your church if you are concerned about your health and prefer to return home.
- Temperature checks will be taken at the door once a day. Anyone with a temperature over 100.4 will not be permitted to enter the building.
- Hand sanitizer, masks and other resources will be available at the doors upon request.
- Be prepared to answer the following questions:
 - If you have been in close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19? ○
 - Experienced a cough, shortness of breath, or sore throat? ○
 - Had a fever of 100.4?
 - Had a new loss of taste or smell?
 - Had vomiting or diarrhea?
- Masks should be worn at your discretion, particularly in common areas and with any interaction with others.
- Please keep in mind social distancing and in areas.
- Strict attention will be complied with Gatlinburg Convention Center. Make yourself aware of local policies. Masks will be discretionary of all visitors.
- The Gatlinburg Convention Center will continue to do sanitization cleaning. Your assistance in wiping down areas in your personal space will be helpful.
- All precautions, including following universal guidelines for the State of Tennessee, should be observed during the retreat to help prevent the spread of any disease, especially COVID-19.
- We are prepared to practice social distancing by adding a second service and dividing our crowds for minimum capacity in the worship / conference area.
